We owe huge thanks to Ken and Colum for long persistence in getting us to this point! We are also grateful for the Benefact Cathedral Grants for 2023 and 2024, together with the MacNab Trust Grant which together have covered most of the cost.

UNFORTUNATE ORGAN NEWS...UPDATE

Following contact from our organ technician, he points sadly to the terminal demise of the organ. The Vestry will therefore be starting the process to decide our next steps. Over the coming weeks we will be using the piano, with permission given from Oban Music Society for which we are very grateful, and the Clavinova.

There will obviously be a need to fundraise and we start a campaign very soon! In 1994 the organ cost £23,500, costs now are slightly more for a good second-hand with comparable specifications or considerably greater for a new organ. We will keep the congregation informed—please start thinking how you can help us raise the money needed....


